
Use as:

- 5- a small group for personal job assignments

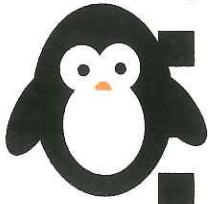
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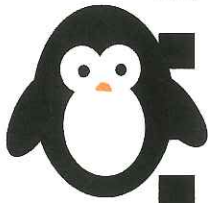
Pick a character from the chapter that reminds you most of yourself. Describe why it makes you think of your own self. Use examples from the story. Don't forget to use character traits!
